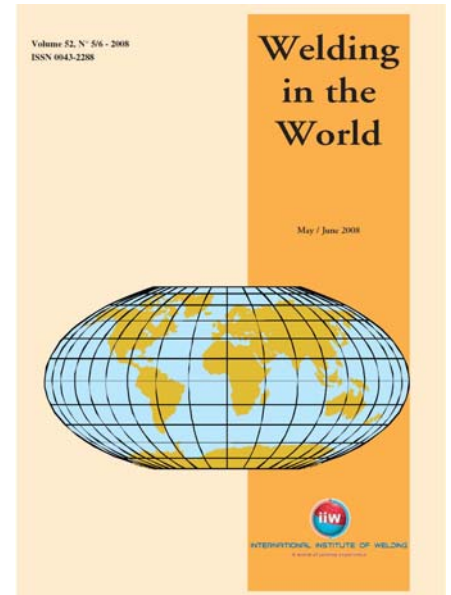
### **The worldwide reference in the fields of welding and joining**
